


## Tardy Policy and Consequences Chart Wharton High School 2021-2022 Accumulated by Three Weeks

Wharton High School tardy policy is effective for each class the student attends.

Students will be issued a detention on their **3rd tardy**. A tardy is defined as when the student does not cross the marked threshold of the classroom door before the tardy bell rings. The following are guidelines and procedures for the tardy policy:

- D-Hall will last from 12:06 pm 1:09 pm in TB 2-A
- Tardy weeks are aligned with the 9 week grading period and will start over every 3 weeks. (Weeks 1, 4, 7 weeks of a 9 week grading period will start the three week tardy policy)
- D-Hall for tardies is held every day.
- Students will receive a tardy D–Hall slip notifying them of the date of the d hall.
  Students are responsible for informing their parents of a d–hall assignment.
  Administrators will assign the discipline as follows:



Tardy 9 - 10	
Parent Phone Call	1 -3 Days of ISS; 1 Day of OSS per tardy
Tardy 10 - Above	
Mandatory Parent Meeting	1 - 3 days of OSS per tardy
