One: One Support Support a student with their academic or behavioral struggles or needs

Data Collection Collect individual student data observations or RTIs

Review + Remediate Review and remediate skills and deficits from data, assessments, and daily observations

Circulate & Feedback Support students while they are working on assignments and provide immediate feedback to correct any misunderstandings

Monitor & Redirect monitoring and redirecting behavior ensuring everyone is participating in the lesson

The Fundamental 5 Wharton Elementary School "Teacher of the Week" is Mrs. Katie Garza. Mrs. Garza is a 3rd grade math and science teacher and the 3rd grade level leader. She has been teaching at Wharton Elementary for 5 years. She has taught 5th grade reading, 2nd grade self contained and 3rd grade math. She is a graduate of Wharton ISD and she received her bachelor's degree from the University of Houston-Victoria. She and her husband have three beautiful children; Roy who is 10, Brooklyn who is 1 and Jasper who is 8 months old. Mrs. Garza loves spending quality time with her family.

Mrs. Garza has done an exceptional job progressing her students. She does a great job of pulling small groups daily in her math classes. The highlight this week was her effectiveness of "Framing the Lesson" and "Exit Tickets" Mrs. Garza "frames her lessons" by posting the learning objectives in student friendly language on the board for students to reference during the lesson. She also restates the lesson objective throughout her lessons. She ends her lessons with students doing an exit ticket activity that allows students to show their knowledge of the lesson's objective. She incorporates SGPTs in her lessons which provides students the opportunity to talk and discuss their learning. Mrs. Garza really enjoys creating relationships with her students. She loves the look on her students' faces when they have that "Ha Ha" moment. Wharton Elementary is very fortunate to have Mrs. Garza.





Instructional Strategies of the Week

Our campus will begin a new **Fundamental 5**

Instructional Strategy of "Framing the Lesson" and the Playbook Focus will the "Small Group Purposeful Talks (SGPT)". Students learn the instructional content better if they find material more relevant. Use and post the "We will" and "I will" statements and refer to the "We will" statement throughout the lesson. SGPTs are after 10-15 minutes of teacher talk and followed by 3-5 minutes of student talk that is planned and posted for students.

Fundamental 5

Framing the Lesson:

- Students learn the instructional content better if they find material more relevent.
- Use and post the "We will" and "I will" statements.
- Refer to the "We will" statement throughout the lesson.

Playbook Focus

Small Group Purposeful Talks:

- Is the practice of having planned, content based discussion between 2-4 students following every 10-15 minutes of teacher-driven discussion.
- Helps students process the information from the lesson.
- Allows students to discover and engage with a range of perspectives, ideas and backgrounds




