Ms. Garcia works extremely hard and is willing to help in any capacity. She provides excellent customer service to our parents and students. WJH thank you for all you do!

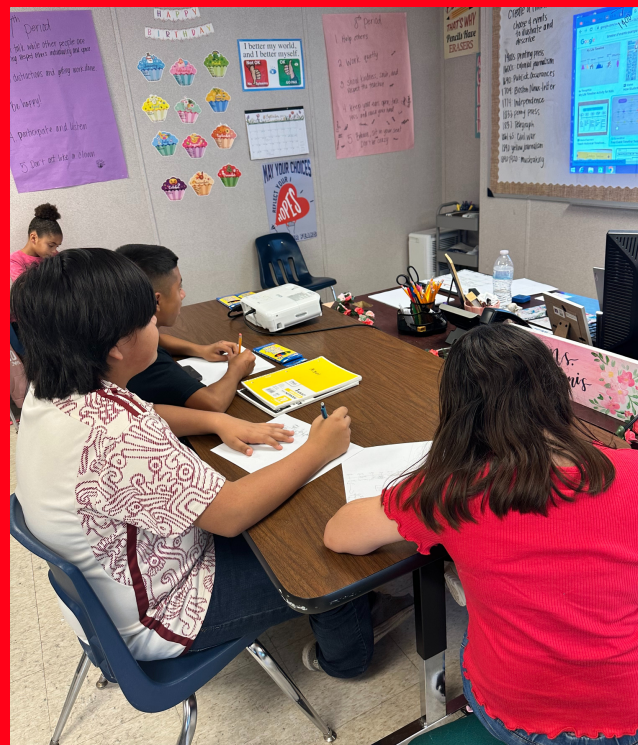
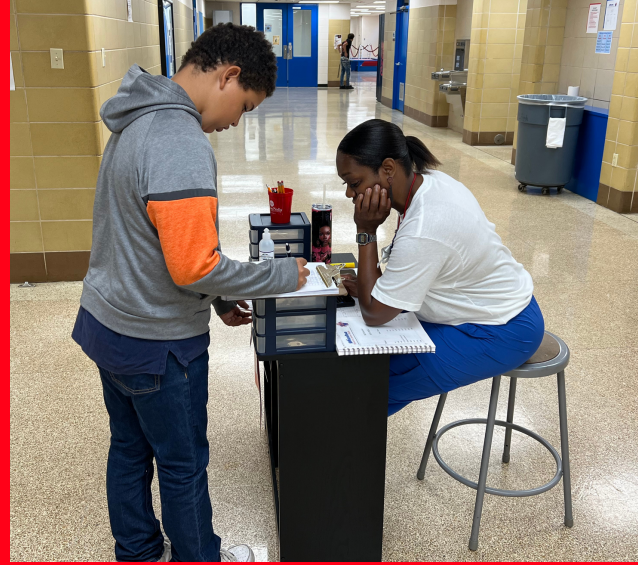
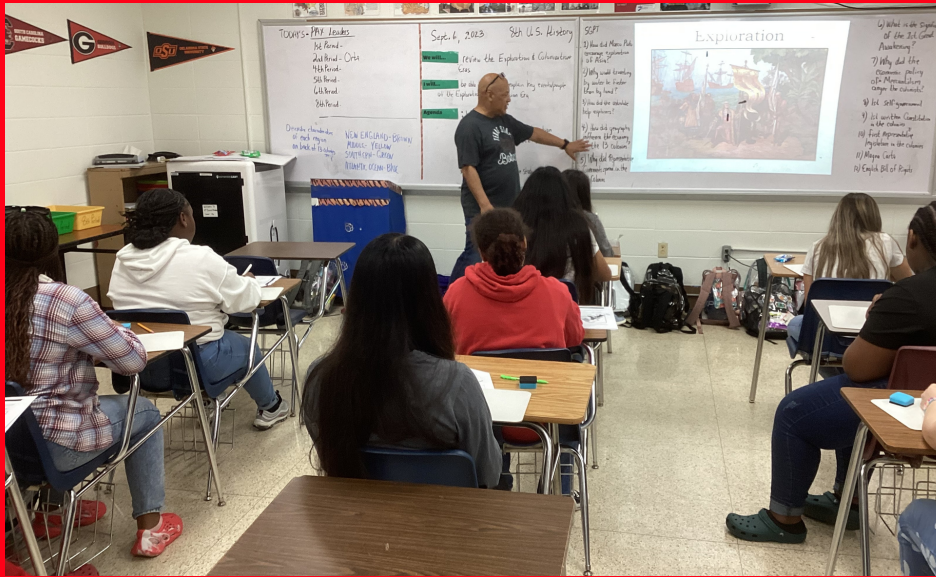
