- **This is Duty Week: White**

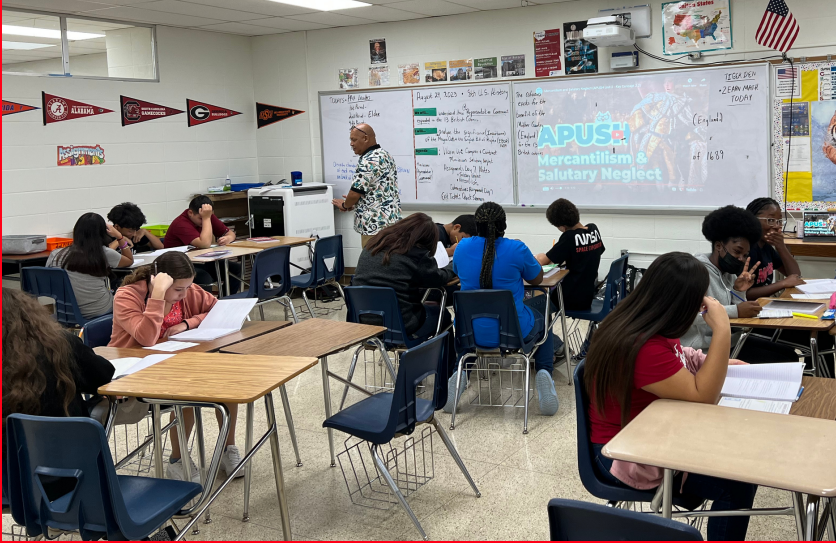
FRIENDLY REMINDERS

- **Grades must be entered weekly; 4 non-major and 1 major.**

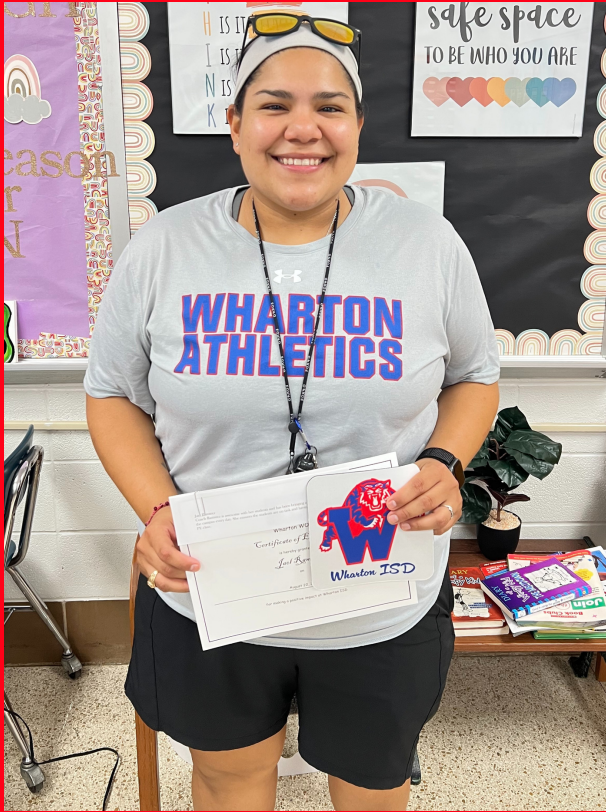
A MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

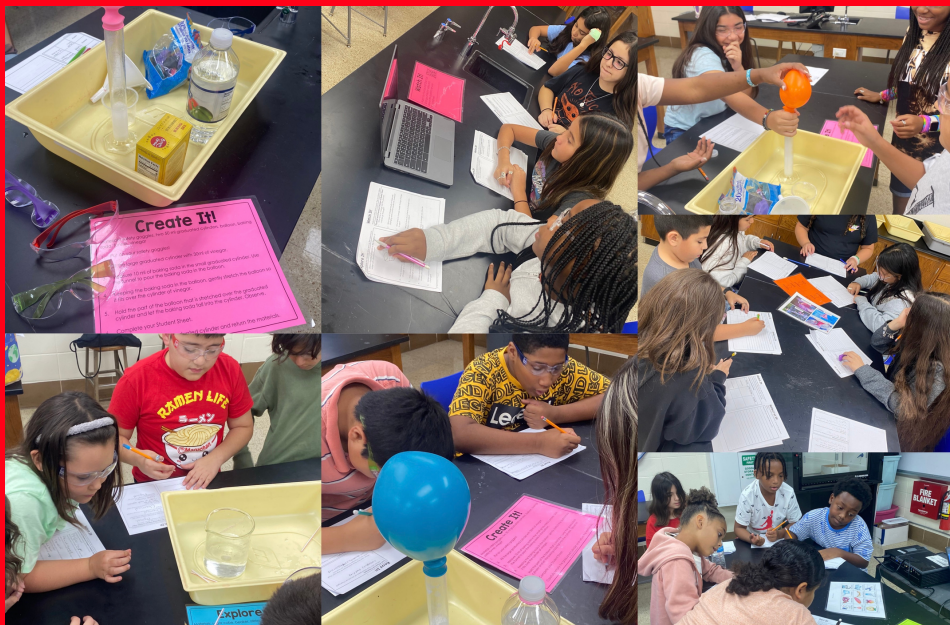



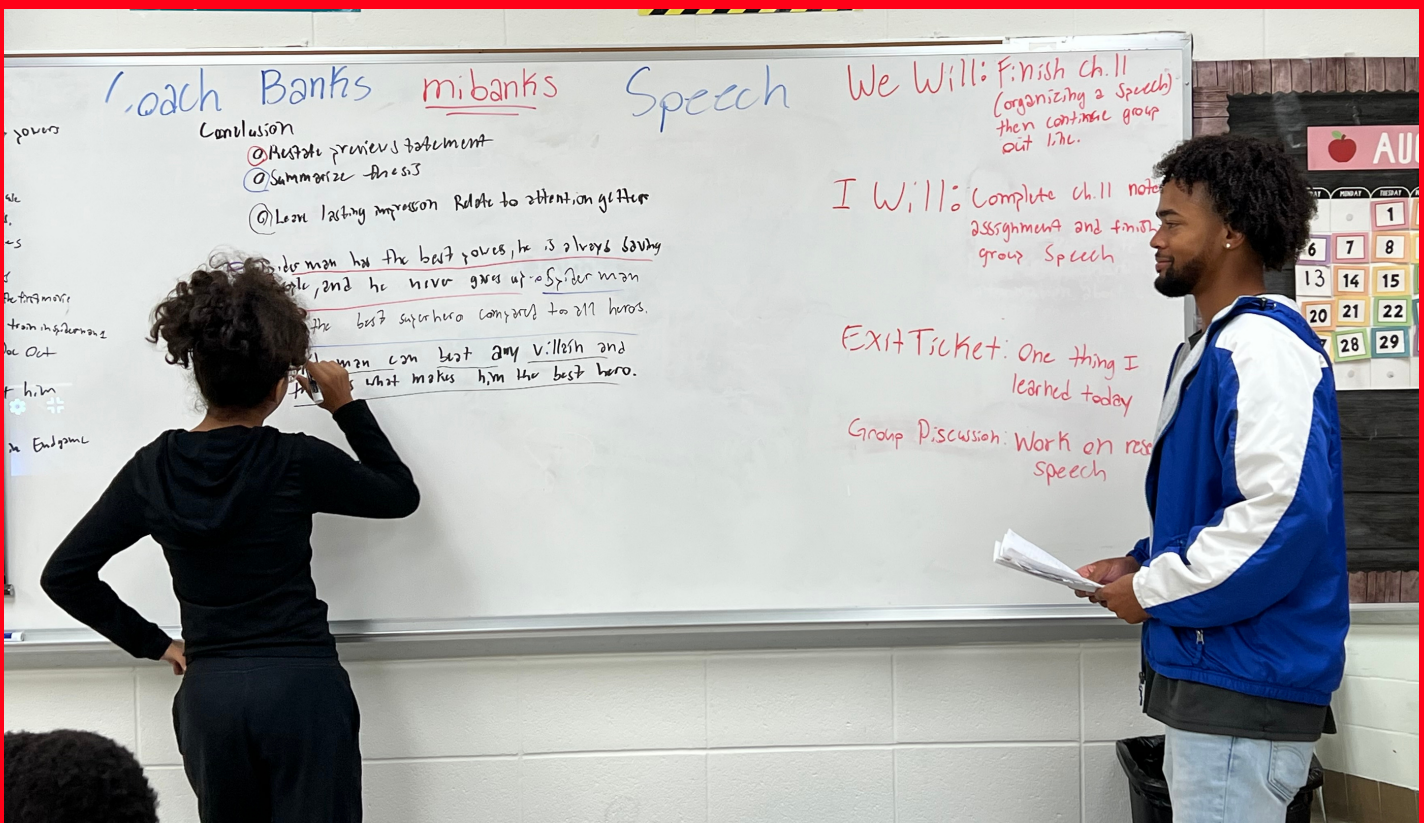
